

- 1. Did God foreknow the end of his plan as it relates to man from the beginning? (Isaiah 46:9-11; Acts 15:18) YES Has the period in which sin is permitted been a dark night to humanity, never to be forgotten? __YES____ The Sun of Righteousness will bring __HEALING____ and __BLESSING____. (Malachi 4:2) Joy will come "in the morning" to the groaning creation because _GOD_ has promised it. (Psalm 30:5; Isaiah 35:10)
- 2. The whole creation is **__GROANING___** and travailing in pain because of Adam's **DISOBEDIENCE**. (Romans 8:22; Romans 5:12) The great Creator is preparing a **___FEAST___** of fat things for man. (Isaiah 25:6-8) Are God's thoughts and ways higher than those of man? (Isaiah 55:8-10) **__YES__**
- 3. The past is called the __WORLD__ that was. (2 Peter 3:6) Evil has predominated during the second dispensation or _WORLD that now is. (Galatians 1:4) The third dispensation will be a __WORLD without end. (Isaiah 45:17) It is now possible to understand "present" truth because we are in the dawning of the _MILLENNIAL_ age. (Isaiah 21:12; 52:7, 8; Daniel 12:9-12; Matthew 24:45-47; Psalm 89:15)
- 4. All faith should be built upon the word of _GOD_. (Psalm 119: 105; 2 Tim. 3:16, 17) In order to understand the truth it is necessary to _REASON_ with the Lord by means of the scriptures. (Isa. 1:18; Acts 17:2; Luke 24:32) _JUSTICE_ and judgment are the foundation of God's throne. (Psa. 89:14)
- 5. It is necessary to search the _SCRIPTURES_ if one is to learn the truth. (John 5:39; Acts 17:10, 11; 2 Timothy 2:15, 16) The Bible reveals God's _PLAN_. (Rev. 1:1-3; Gen. 22:15-18; Acts 15:14-17) The spirit of _TRUTH_ guides the truth seeker into all truth. (1 Corinthians 2:9, 10; John 16:13; Isaiah 61:1-3)

- 6. Is the truth progressive, shining more and more unto the perfect day? (Proverbs 4:18) _YES____ The truth seeker should shun __PROFANE__ and vain babblings. (2 Timothy 2:16-18) Some of the divinely appointed helps are _APOSTLES___, _PROPHETS, and PASTORS; ETC.(Eph. 4:11-16)
- 7. Do many people believe certain doctrines because others do so and teach error in all good conscience? (Acts 26:9) _YES_ The truth seeker should empty his vessel of the muddy waters of TRADITION and fill it at the fountain of __TRUTH. (1 Corinthians 5:6, 7; John 17:17)
- **8**. The author of "The Divine Plan of the Ages" endeavored to be as brief as possible because of the **_HASTE_** of our day.
- 9. Is thorough and orderly study of the divine revelation necessary? (1Timothy 4:15, 16; 2 Timothy 2:15; Hebrews 2:1) __YES__ Are the subjects of our Lord's second presence, the symbols, and the prophecies of the Bible often neglected? (2 Peter 3:1-5; 1 Thessalonians 5:6, 7) __YES__
- 10. Do the angels desire to understand the revealed purposes of God? (1 Peter 1:12) __YES__ Prophecy is given to acquaint the student with _FUTURE_ events and to note the fulfilment of prophecies pertaining to the __PAST__ and the _PRESENT_. (1 Peter 1:10, 11; Luke 10:21; 2 Timothy 3:16, 17)
- 11. Has God's plan been a miserable failure? (Isaiah 6:9, 10; Acts 28:25-27) __NO__ Did Jesus at the first advent endeavor to convert the world? (Mark 4:11, 12) _NO__
- **12**. Upon whom must one call if he is to be saved? (Acts 4:12) __**JESUS**__
- 13. In 1886 the population of earth was approximately _1,424,000,000_; today it is about 6 billion.

- The percentage of the heathen in the world is considerably more than 50% (1/2); it is almost $_{67\%}$ (2/3).
- **14**. Are all who attend Church fully consecrated to the Lord? _NO_ How many will be of the "little flock"? (Revelation 14:1; Luke 12:32) **144,000**
- **15**. During the past 6000 years, have vast multitudes died in unbelief? (Matthew 7:13) **YES**
- **16**. Did it ever enter into the mind of the great Creator to everlastingly torment any of his creatures? (Jeremiah 32:34, 35) __NO; NEVER__
- 17. In 1886, appproximately 100,000 people died every 24 hours. Is that number much higher today?_YES__
- 18. The world will be judged in RIGHTEOUSNESS by the Christ. (Acts 17:31) Did Isaiah prophesy of the darkness of the civilized world and the gross darkness of the heathen? (Isaiah 60:2, 3) YES
- **19**. Has the darkness in the world been such as could be felt? (Romans 1:18-25) **YES**_
- **20**. Is the unfolding and blessing of the truth now coming to the sincere, the pure in heart? (Revelation 3:18) _YES_
- 21. Is it possible to reason with the Lord? (Isaiah 1:18) _YES_ In order to clearly apprehend the truth, one must have what? (Hebrews 11:6) __FAITH__ Light is sown for the __RIGHTEOUS_. (Psalm 97:11) God's _WORD__ lights our path. (Psalm 119:105) The path of the justified is as the shining LIGHT__. (Proverbs 4:18) None is perfect because of ADAM'S/ONE MAN'S sin. (Romans 3:10; 5:12) Are the justified privileged to see the present unfolding of God's plan as well as things to come? (Romans 5: 1, 2) __YES___ Are there due seasons during which the truth becomes due to be understood? (Matthew 24:45; 2 Peter 1:12) ____YES__
- **22**. Those who have faith in the promises of the Lord _REJOICE__. Some sit in darkness because of their _UNFAITHFULNESS_ and unconcern. (Matthew 14:31; Luke 12:28; Psalm 1:1)
- 23. The holy scriptures make one ____WISE__. (2 Timothy 3:15)
- **24**. The hidden things of __DARKNESS__ are being brought to light during the _MILLENNIAL__ age. (Isa. 21:12; 1 Cor. 4:5; Zech. 14:6, 7)
- 25. God promised Abraham that in his seed all the FAMILIES/NATIONS of the earth will be blessed. (Genesis 22:15-18) The law was a __SHADOW__ of good things to come. (Heb. 10:1) Israel, as a whole, did not accept our Lord at the first advent; because of their unbelief and blindness in part they were __BROKEN__ off. (Romans 11:20, 25) Because of the unbelief of many Jews, the invitation to become joint-heirs with Christ went to the GENTILES in 36 A.D. (Acts 15:14)

- **26**. The **_LITTLE**_ flock will be in the spiritual phase of the kingdom. (Luke 12:32; Rom. 8:17; 2 Tim. 2:11) Life and **_IMMORTALITY**_ were brought to light by the gospel of **_JESUS**_. (2 Tim. 1:10) The spirit of **_TRUTH**__ enables one to understand spiritual things. (John 16:12-13; 1 Cor. 2:12-14)
- 27. The majority in the church began to neglect the word after the __APOSTLES___ fell asleep. (Acts 20:28-31; 2 Thessalonians 2:3-7)
- 28. The mystery of iniquity began to be revealed at the time of the __REFORMATION_. (2 Thess. 2:7) Some of the reformers were _MELANCHTHON_, LUTHER / KNOX, and __WYCLIFFE___. Are the creeds of men still believed by the majority? __YES_
- **29**. Are special features of truth constantly becoming due? __YES____
- **30**. In God's word there is __MILK__ for the babes and strong __MEAT___ for those more developed. (1 Peter 2:2; Hebrews 5:14) Truth called "meat in due season" is now being served by our returned Lord through the _FAITHFUL___ and wise servant. (Luke 12:42) Can new things be brought forth from the creeds of the various sects? (Matthew 13:52) __NO
- **31**. Is God's character misrepresented by the creeds of men? (Isaiah 29:13) _YES__ The word of God will make one _WISE_. (2 Timothy 3:15-17; 1 Timothy 4:16) The faithful student should be able to express his HOPE. (1 Peter 3:15) The dawn of the Millennial day brings ENLIGHTENMENT as well as trouble. (2 Pet. 1:19; 3:10)
- **32**. Men_SIT_ in darkness and _STAND_ among the ungodly. Some _WALK_ in the light and __RUN_ for the prize. (Isaiah 42:7; Psalm 1:1; Hebrews 12:1)
- 33. Is perfection of knowledge a thing of the past? (1 Corinthians 13:9, 10) __NO____ God has made known to the fully consecrated the mystery of his WILL___ which he purposed in himself. (Ephesians 1:9, 10, 17, 18; Ephesians 3:4-6) The angels and the prophets could not understand the mystery of God's will because they were not invited to become the bride of __CHRIST___. (1 Peter 1:10-13)
- **34.** Did the apostles have different degrees of insight into God's plan? (Acts 10:28; Acts 11:1-3; Galatians 2:11-14)_YES___
- **35**. The entire church has benefited by the visions and revelations given to the Apostle __PAUL____. (2 Corinthians 12:4; Galatians 2:2)
- **36.** A blessing awaits those who study the book of Revelation as well as the entire **BIBLE** (Rev. 1:1-3)
- **37**. Did Luther understand some of the book of Revelation? **YES**_
- **38.** More truth is now due to be understood during the harvest of the Gospel age and the dawning of the Millennial age because our Lord is at the door **__KNOCKING_**. (Revelation 3:20)
