1. According to the prevailing *theory* of the day of judgment, all receive their sentence and reward at **DEATH**. If an unalterable decision is made at death, would there be any purpose of another judgment? <u>NO</u>

2. According to the prevailing *theory* of the day of judgment, how much time is assigned to the work of judging billions of people? <u>24 HOURS</u>

3. Is this crude conception of the day of judgment out of harmony with the inspired word? <u>YES</u> In the parable of the sheep and the goats, the <u>SHEEP</u> represent those who are *meek*, and the <u>GOATS</u> represent those who are *stubborn*. (Matthew 25:31-46) An illustration of a truth by something, which is in many respects, like it is called a <u>PARABLE</u>. If the parable of the sheep and the goats were a *literal* statement, it would apply to literal <u>SHEEP</u> and literal <u>GOATS</u>.

4. The term "<u>JUDGMENT</u>" signifies a trial as well as a decision based on that trial.

5. The term *day*, in addition to representing 24 hours, also signifies any <u>DEFINITE</u> or special period of <u>TIME</u>. Was the *day* that the Creator made the earth and the heavens a long definite period? <u>YES</u> (Genesis 2:4) The *day* of temptation in the wilderness was <u>40</u> years. (Hebrews 3:8, 9) The *day* of Christ at his second advent is <u>1000</u> years. (2 Peter 3:8) During the mediatorial phase of the kingdom the world will be judged in <u>**RIGHTEOUSNESS**</u>. (Acts 17:31)

6. Are complete concordances helpful to the Bible student? <u>YES</u>

7. The masses of mankind will have their complete **TRIAL** during the Millennial age (mediatorial phase). (Acts 17:31; 1 Corinthians 6:2) 8. The whole human race, as represented in Adam, stood trial at the beginning in **<u>EDEN</u>**. What was the verdict? **GUILTY** What was the penalty? **DEATH** (Gen. 2:17) Has the decision of the Judge ever since been enforced? YES 9. The wrath of God is revealed against all UNRIGHTEOUSNESS _____. The wrath of God is seen, witnessed, and felt in every FUNERAL, tomb, ache, and PAIN . Mankind will be recovered from the sentence of the first trial because of the one sacrifice for **ALL**. Since Jesus died for all, it is proper to speak of death as being a temporary <u>SLEEP</u>. Who will awaken those who are asleep? **LIFE-GIVER** Have the fully consecrated been released from the original sentence? <u>YES</u> Their escape is reckoned by what? **FAITH** . The more than **OVERCOMERS** will be satisfied to awake in our Redeemer's likeness. (Psalm 17:15; Rom. 8:37) Has the heavenly Father provided for the deliverance of others after the resurrection of the church? **YES** The Gospel age is the trial day for those called to the **<u>DIVINE</u>** nature. **10.** Was the general sentence of Adam unjust

10. Was the general sentence of Adam unjust and too severe? <u>NO</u> God has provided a <u>**REDEMPTION**</u> from the penalty of the first judgment. Adam and all his <u>**DESCENDANTS**</u> have experienced sin and its results. Has God changed one iota from his original purpose? <u>NO</u> Our Redeemer (*substitute*) is <u>JESUS</u>. Please give a scripture citation *proving* that Jesus tasted death for *every* man. HEBREWS 2:9

Our Lord Jesus can justly give a new offer of life to the race of Adam because he has provided a <u>**RANSOM**</u> for Adam's race. The church is offered life under the covenant of <u>**SACRIFICE**</u>. (Psalm 50:5; Romans 12:1) The offer of life to the world will be under the <u>**NEW**</u> Covenant.

11. Christ will have the privilege of judging the world because of his <u>OBEDIENCE</u> even unto death. (John 5:22) What *nature* does our Lord have since his resurrection from the dead? <u>DIVINE</u> Who has been given all power in

heaven and in earth? (Matthew 28:18) **JESUS**

12. JEHOVAH has appointed Christ to judge the world. The <u>CHARACTER</u> of the Judge is a sufficient guarantee that the *judgment day* will be <u>JUST</u> and merciful.

13. A judge in olden times executed <u>JUSTICE</u> and relieved the <u>OPPRESSED</u>. Did God raise up judges to relieve Israel when under oppression by their enemies because of transgression against the Lord? <u>YES</u> Satan has **OPPRESSED** the people.

14. The world of mankind will be judged in **<u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>**. (Psalm 98:9)

15. In the coming judgment of the world, the reward of obedience will be perfect human **LIFE**. What will be the *penalty* for disobedience? **DEATH** The second trial will be more favorable _____ gained. due to the **EXPERIENCE** Will any then die because of inherited imperfections? **__NO___** If one then *eats the sour grape of sin* his **TEETH** shall be set on edge. (Jeremiah 31:29, 30) Can a *soul* die if it sins? (Ezekiel 18:4) ____YES_ Will a man be judged according to something he doesn't have? (2 Cor. 8:12) ____ Will mankind be gradually educated, trained and disciplined? **YES** Perfect harmony with God will be required when man has reached **PERFECTION** . Will any be permitted to have everlasting life who then in the slightest degree fall short of perfection? **NO**

16. Any who sin <u>WILFULLY</u> will die the *second death*. One who is making some progress, after the highway of holiness is opened, will have at least <u>100</u> years. (Isaiah 65:20) 17. The <u>OBEDIENT</u> and the<u>DISOBEDIENT</u> will have been completely separated by the close of the judgment day. (Matthew 25:31-46; Revelation 20:15; 21:8; 1 Corinthians 15:25) Will there be a release from the second death? <u>NO</u> Those who die the *second death* <u>SIN</u> wilfully against full light and <u>OPPORTUNITY</u>.

18. Does man have a present responsibility according to the light enjoyed? <u>YES</u> Will the good and evil deeds of the present time receive a just recompense of reward either now *or* hereafter? <u>YES</u> (Proverbs 15:3; Ecclesiastes 12:14; 1 Timothy 5:24)
Only the *little flock* have, as yet, sufficient light to die the *second* <u>DEATH</u> if they sin wilfully.
19. About <u>6000</u> years intervenes between the world's first and second judgment days.

20. The house of servants was selected *before* the <u>GOSPEL/CHRISTIAN</u> age. The house of sons is being selected *during* the <u>GOSPEL</u> age. The world of mankind will be judged during the <u>MILLENNIAL</u> age. The ancient worthies will be made <u>PRINCES</u> in the earthly phase of the kingdom. (Psalm 45:16) The <u>SAINTS</u> will judge the world. (1 Corinthians 6:2)

21. Will the house of servants and the house of sons (Hebrews 3:5, 6) be accounted worthy of high exaltation to stations of honor and authority? **YES**

22. The trial of the above classes has been more severe than the trial of the <u>WORLD</u> will be in its judgment day. This is true because they have had <u>SATAN</u> opposing them. Will Satan be fully bound at the time the great time of trouble is stopped?
<u>YES</u> The reward of the house of servants and the house of sons will be greater than that of the WORLD .

23. The nominal church regards the day of judgment with <u>FEAR</u>. Do nominal Christians know of the blessings in store for the world? <u>NO</u> Many errors have crept into the creeds and <u>HYMN</u> books.

24. The prophets and the apostles wrote concerning the blessings of the <u>JUDGMENT</u> day. (1 Chronicles 16:31-34)
